Full-led headlights

Full-LED headlights with dynamic rear indicators providing all light functions via LEDs consist of three modules, a main LED module for dipped and full beams, and three LED chambers for the cornering and side lights.



Virtual cocpit

The 10.25" virtual cockpit, a digital instrument panel, is an all-new feature for the model. It offers up to five display modes (classic, modern, reduced, enhanced, and sport). In addition to other items, the display can show a navigation map with a close-up bar, filling stations, route length, and driving time.



Wireless charging

The charging box (optional) is a storage compartment that allows for wireless mobile phone charging. In addition, it amplifies the mobile signal, thanks to a connection with the external antenna. As a result, your family or colleagues can even reach you in locations without great signal coverage.



Boot space

The fourth-generation Fabia is the largest Fabia to date. Thus, the boot volume is also the biggest ever – 380 litres in the basic configuration and 1,190 litres with the rear-seat backrests folded down.



Advanced assistance systems

The new Škoda Fabia offers seven assistance system for the first time ever. These are the Travel Assist 2.0, Automatic Parking, Lane Assist, Traffic Sign Recognition, Side Assist, Front Assist with Predictive Pedestrian and Cyclist Protection, and Manoeuvre Assist. All are designed to improve both safety and comfort.



Connectivity

Due to smart phones can be connected Android Auto and Apple CarPlay. The infotainment system will enable you to use many Škoda Connect online services such as eCall (in the event of an accident, it automatically launches an emergency call) and services under the MyŠkoda application that enable you to control the car remotely.



Fuel tank



Passive safety






